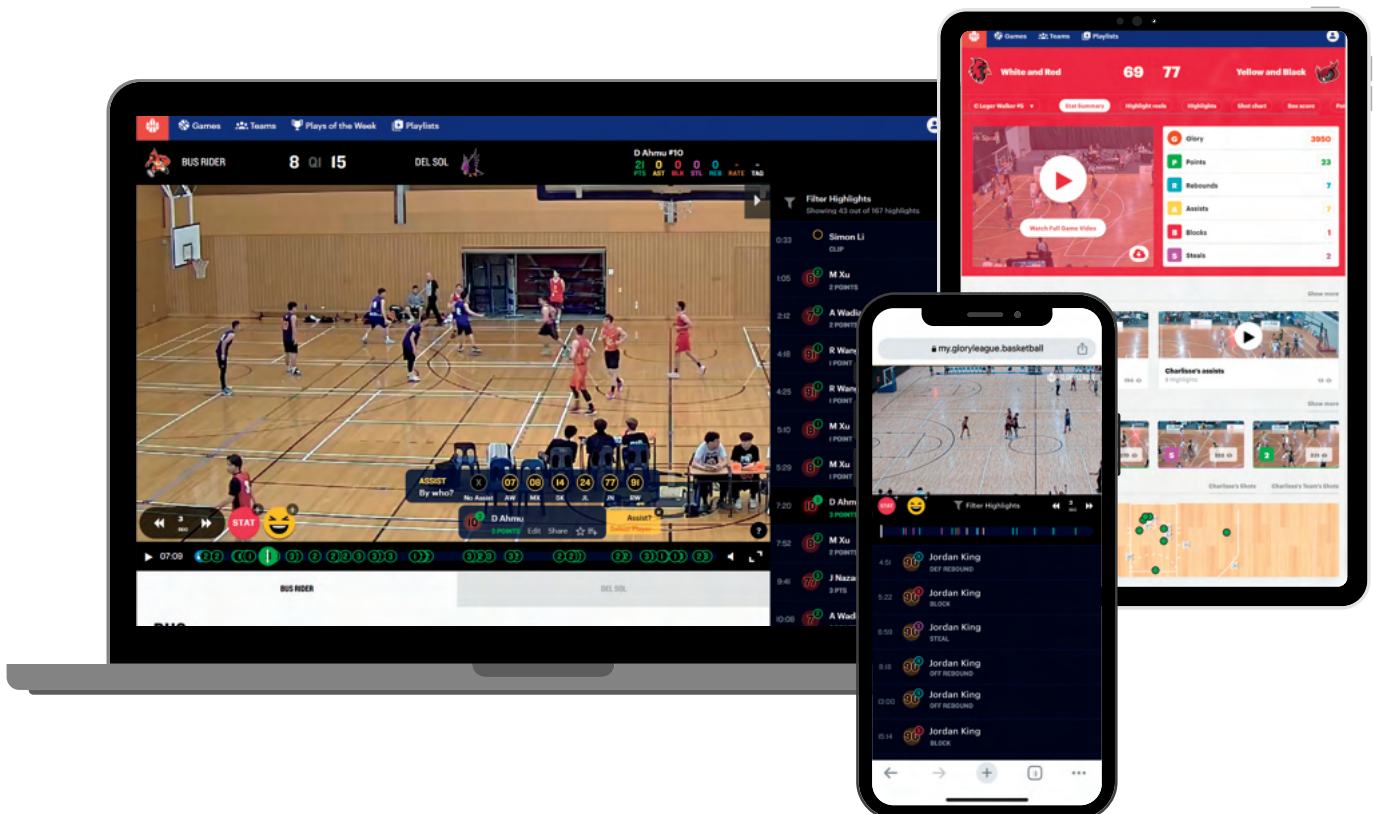
WHAT IS GLORY LEAGUE?

Glory League is a fully automated video engagement system for basketball.

It makes everyday players feel like superstars with professional quality full game videos, highlight reels and stats.

Glory League automatically creates personalised videos and highlights that can be easily shared with family and friends – connecting the community to their basketball experience.

The results have been phenomenal with over 80% of all players using Glory League after games, and spending over 10 minutes on the system per visit. Glory League gets players hooked on the game by capturing amazing on-court memories and moments, so they live on beyond the hardwood.



HOW DOES GLORY LEAGUE WORK?

Glory League is easy to install and use.

By integrating with competition management and scoring systems, there is no additional administration required by teams, clubs or associations.

A camera is mounted above the court and our automated software zooms in and follows the game, just like a professional camera operator. The scoring system starts the recording and each point scored is automatically cut into highlight videos for the participants. After the game players, coaches, parents and supporters are emailed a link to the video, automated highlight reels and statistics.

Videos are easily watched and shared so the basketball community can relive their favourite moments again and again.



WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

ATTRACT AND RETAIN PLAYERS

The competition to attract and retain participants in sport has never been greater. It is a constant challenge to keep basketball players engaged, motivated and supported so they will stay in the game.

Other sports, social activities, gaming and the online world are competing for time and attention – people can only do so many things. Participants want their basketball journey supported and for most players, their basketball experience hasn't lived beyond the court.

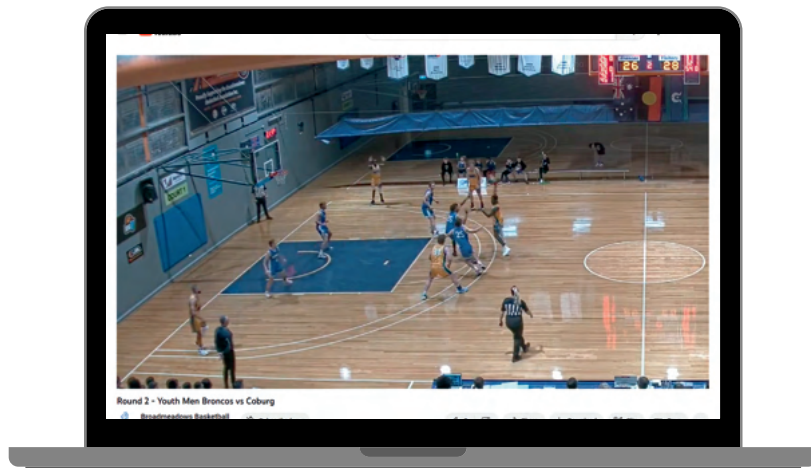

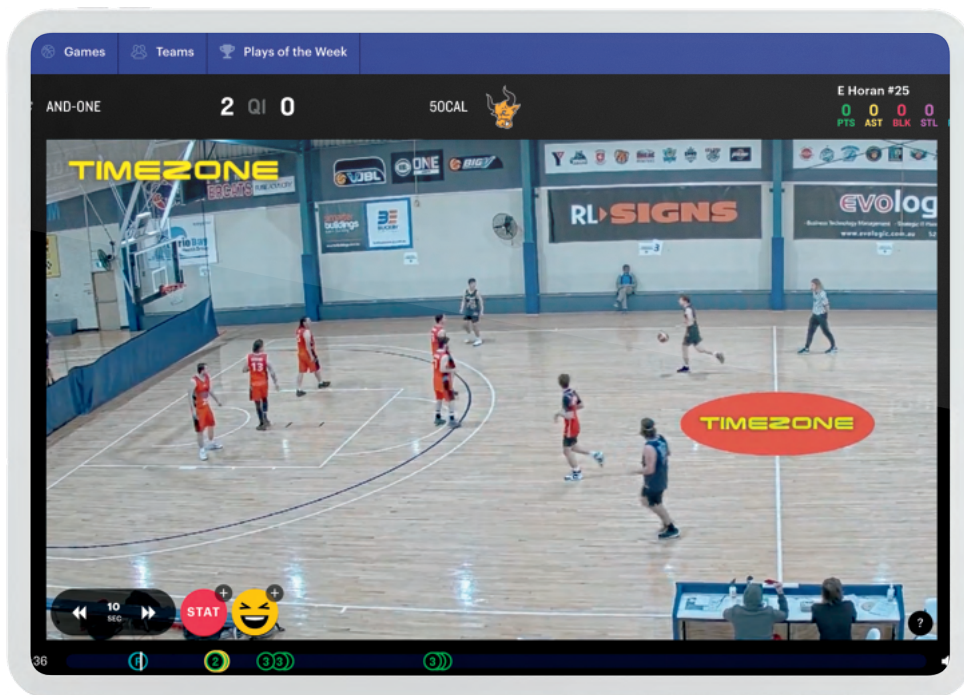

INFRASTRUCTURE

Glory League combines networked court cameras, scoring systems, and a local hard wired internet connection to produce game videos and collect statistics.

SMALL SERVER BOX

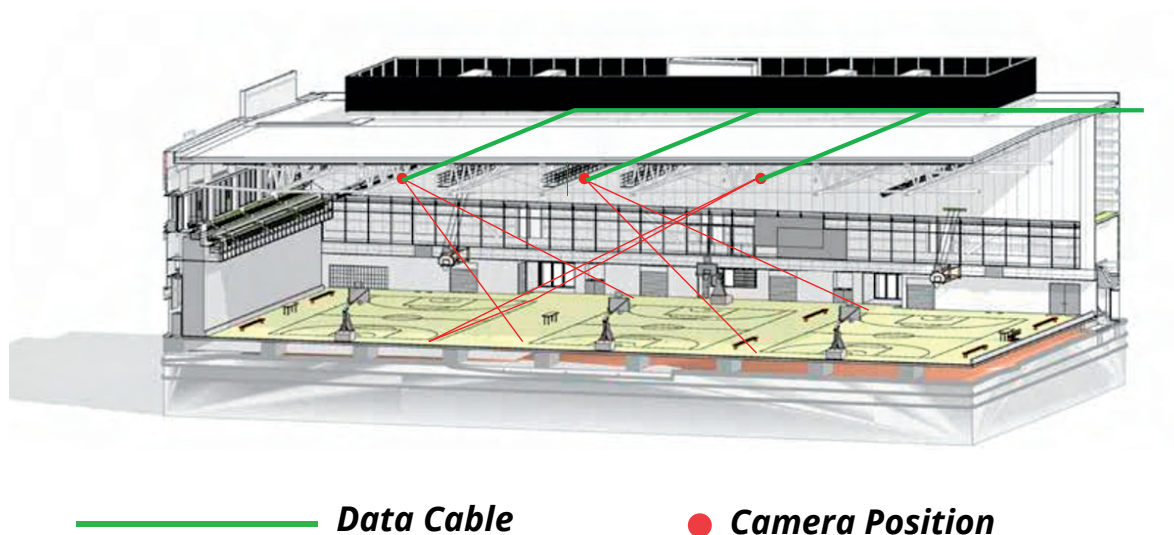
Stores the Glory League server and switch. The box is plugged into the venues power and data connection. It is usually located in the venues data room.



SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Glory League combines networked court cameras, scoring systems, and a local hard wired internet connection to produce game videos and collect statistics.

CAMERA POSITIONING

A Glory League representative will help determine the appropriate camera type and position for a court camera. This will be at the most desirable viewing angle available.

INSTALLATION

Our regional installation partner will visit the site to prepare an installation plan, finalising the camera and server installation location, timeframes, and installation process. This will be done in full consultation with the venue and client.

HOW OFTEN IS GLORY LEAGUE USED?

Glory League enhances the experience for the entire Basketball community. Players, coaches, referees, families, and friends watch, share and engage heavily on Glory League:

- ✔ Over 80% of participants use the system after a game.
- ✔ Average 10 minutes watching per session.

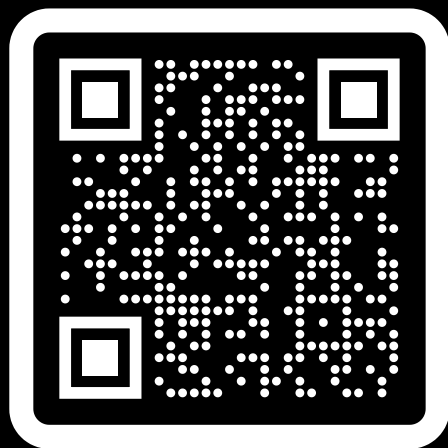
