BNSW MEMBERSHIP

All managers, coaches and players in our Primary and Junior competitions must be registered with BNSW through BasketballConnect. Managers and Coaches should upload their WWCC to their BasketballConnect profile for verification.

Players names will be removed automatically from the team list upon expiry of their annual BNSW membership. A unique link will be emailed by BasketballConnect prior to expiry. Once renewed players name will reappear on the team list.

Players from other Associations who wish to participate in our competitions need to pay the Affiliation fee which will expire at the same time as their Primary membership.

TEAM REGISTRATION

Existing teams are provided with a priority registration link for team registration through BasketballConnect (existing team name and minimum of 4 existing players must be used to be valid). If there is room available, registrations will be offered to those on our waiting list in order of date enquiry received. Please contact the office for further information if your existing team wishes to register with less than 4 original players.

Any team that uses the priority registration link who is not authorised to do so, will have their money refunded and placed back on the waiting list.

All team entries are required to have a minimum of 6 players invited to the team at time of registration. Players must accept the invitation and be financial members of BNSW prior to their first game. Please ensure that you have players full name and contact details as originally registered with BNSW to avoid duplicating a member's account.

Team Entry is charged at the beginning of every season and is payable at time of registration by credit card. After registration you can change your credit card details or change to direct debit. This can be done via your profile in the BasketballConnect app. If your team is changing managers/coach please ensure that there is only one credit card attached to the team for weekly debit.

Weekly court fees are automatically charged to the manager's account prior to your team's game. There are no other payment options available. Where there is a late forfeit and your credit card has already been charged, a refund via BasketballConnect will be submitted. Where weekly court fees have been rejected by your nominated credit/debit account another attempt will be made prior to your next game.

Managers are able to see if their players have accepted their invitation to join the team. Group chats can be set up and you can invite/add new players via the app. Jersey numbers can also be entered via the app or on the scoring tablet prior to the game.

TEAM GRADING

Existing teams will be placed in divisions based on their previous seasons performance. We will also have grading games prior to Season 1's Primary and Junior games starting:

Grades 1-2: No grading

Grades 3-6 Girls: to be completed by Round 3

Grades 7-8 Girls: to be completed by Round 3

Grades 3-6 Boys: to be completed by Round 5

Grades 7-10 Boys: to be completed by Round 5

Womens: No grading, but any changes to be completed by Round 3

Mens: No grading, but any changes to be completed by Round 3

Unisex: No grading

HKBA reserves the right to place teams as befit the team's capabilities and for the benefit of the competition.



REPRESENTATIVE PLAYERS IN PRIMARY AND JUNIOR COMPETITIONS

Players are considered Representative players for the whole calendar year for the purposes of our Local Competition. Development players (train-ons) from other Associations are considered Representative players and will be counted as 3 points for any grade competition.

Maximum of 9 points per team in any division:

- All representative players (including other Association Development Players) playing in their current school grade = 3 points
- HKBA Development players playing in their current school grade = 1.5 points

Where players want to play up a school grade or more a maximum of 9 points per team remains:

- HKBA Representative players playing up one grade or more from their current school grade = 2 points;
- HKBA Development players playing up one grade or more from their current school grade = 1 point
- Other Association Representative and Development players remain at 3 points
